Bus Services

SSIPS takes a very good care of all the needs of its Students. Excellent transportation facilities are rendered to them. The Commuters' bus attendance is a compulsion in all buses. Statistics have shown that College buses are the safest mode of commutation.



Central Library

The Central Library plays a vital role in providing opportunities to the students as well as the Staff Members to enrich their knowledge. It is well maintained with 23709 books, 69 National Journals, 35 International Journals and more than 1000 CDs, which is well above the norms. All operations in the library are fully computerised. We make all efforts to inculcate reading habits in the Students and also to provide them with all necessary assistance. At a time, one student is entitled to issue 3 books in his/her name for a period of 14 days.

Seminar Halls

SSIPS's seminar hall is spread over an area of 2500 sq. feet. It can comfortably accommodate 150 individuals. It is fully air-conditioned and is suitable for Conferences, Symposium, Meetings, Seminars, Concerts, Presentations and Performances. The hall is fully equipped with audio-visual devices providing services such as video conferencing with a sound system and audio-visual material.



Central Computing Facility



The Central Computing Facility has been constituted with the specific objective of providing the most effective cutting-edge resources to equip our students with the latest update in the field of Computer Technology, thus providing them a platform to launch their careers.

The new Central Computing Lab in the Administrative block was inaugurated by His Excellency Honorable Shri Shekhar Dutt, Governor, Chhattisgarh State.

We have a dedicated server for networking, e-campus application and Oracle database saving. All our workstations and servers are connected via 1000 Mbps LAN network. 24 hours Internet facility (155Mbps) is available to the students to explore and learn.

As per Article 32 & 42 of the constitution, broadly speaking, ragging means a disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by any act which has the effect of teasing or handling with rudeness any other student, indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.
